## **DIRECTIONS FOR RECORDING YOUR PERFORMANCE**

## All selections for the class MUST be on the same video!

- 1. Professional recordings are not required for the competition, but good audio and visual quality is very important. The quality on most cell phones is adequate.
- 2. Video recording can be done in home or in studio or in another location.
  - Must include a clear picture of the student performing showing face, hands [in the case of pianist and instrumentalist], and instrument, where applicable.
  - Videos must be a one-take recording. A one-take recording means the whole performance is recorded at once. It does not have to be the first-take recording. Editing or splicing in any form is strictly prohibited.
  - Camera angle must remain consistent throughout the performance.
  - Each class performance should be a separate video.
  - For classes requiring two or more selections, the **complete** performance of all pieces for the class should be performed consecutively in one video without stopping the camera during breaks. Please be aware of time limits, if applicable.
- 3. Video file is uploaded to a private YouTube channel as an 'unlisted' video. These videos can only be viewed by someone with the link. The video link will be needed as part of the submission process.
