

VIRTUAL CLASSES - RECORDING REGULATIONS, ORIGINAL COMPOSITION

1. Professional recordings are not required for the Provincial Music Festival, but good audio and visual quality are very important. The quality of most cell phones is adequate.
2. The performance does not have to be by the composer.
3. Video recording can be done in-home or studio or in another location:
 - Must include a clear picture of the student(s) performing showing face or facial profile and instrument(s);
 - One-take recording;
 - Editing or splicing in any form is strictly prohibited;
 - Camera angle must remain consistent throughout the performance;
 - No acoustic or electronic compensation, filtering, or other enhancement is to be used while [or post] recording;
 - The complete performance of all pieces should be performed consecutively on one video without stopping the camera during breaks. Please be aware of the time limits;
4. Video file is to be uploaded to a YouTube channel as an 'unlisted' video. These videos can only be viewed by someone with the link.
5. A PDF file of the score for each selection performed is named with the following naming convention:
Discipline_Local Festival_Class Number_Competitor Name_Selection and uploaded to Google Drive.
Example: *Original Composition_Truro_9500_Jane Smith_Rondo*
 - The PDF must include the cover and/or title page and all pages of music performed in the competition;
 - The first measure of each line must be numbered.
6. Recorded entries are submitted through the FMFNS website by placing links to the following files in the designated fields of the registration form along with payment of the entry fee on or before the entry deadline stated on page 1 of this document:
 - o The recording for the complete performance as outlined in #3 above;
 - o A clear, scanned copy of each score and named as outlined in #5 above.
7. Each entry is assumed to be the original work of the individual whose name appears on the entry form. Any infraction of this regulation would result in entry disqualification.
8. Competitor does NOT attend the live Provincial Music Festival.
